#### 8. <u>CITY ADMINISTRATOR AND/OR STAFF REPORTS</u>

<u>WWTP Process Upset</u> – The City was experiencing upset conditions at the Wastewater Treatment Plant since April 12<sup>th</sup>. The upset was causing excessive floating sludge and scum in the aeration basin. Staff was working with the City Engineer to determine and remedy the situation. Staff would be investigating industries and other possible sources which may have overloaded the plant and/or introduced excessive soap into the system.

<u>Retail Real Estate Convention</u> – City Administrator Arteaga reported that Mayor Mendoza and himself would be attending the Retail Real Estate Convention in Las Vegas on May 19-22, 2019.
