

**GRANDVIEW CITY COUNCIL
COMMITTEE-OF-THE-WHOLE MEETING MINUTES
NOVEMBER 26, 2019**

1. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Gloria Mendoza called the Committee-of-the-Whole meeting to order at 6:00 p.m., in the Council Chambers at City Hall.

2. OATHS OF OFFICE

City Attorney Plant administered the Oath of Office to Mayor Mendoza following the certification of the election results.

3. ROLL CALL

Present were: Mayor Mendoza and Councilmembers Gay Brewer, David Diaz, Mike Everett, Bill Moore, Javier Rodriguez and Joan Souders.

Absent was Councilmember Diana Jennings.

Staff present were: City Administrator/Public Works Director Cus Arteaga, City Attorney Quinn Plant, City Treasurer Matt Cordray, Assistant Public Works Director Todd Dorsett and City Clerk Anita Palacios.

5. NEW BUSINESS

A. Resolution accepting the bid and authorizing the Grandview Herald as the Official City Newspaper for the year 2020

City Clerk Palacios explained that RCW 35.23.352(7) provided that bids were required to secure the services of the official newspaper. Bids to serve as the Official City Newspaper for the year 2020 were opened on November 19, 2019. The City received two (2) bids from the Grandview Herald and Yakima Herald-Republic. The bids were as follows:

B. Ordinance amending Section 6.06.010 Dangerous Dog Definitions of the Grandview Municipal Code to comply with Laws of 2019, Engrossed House Bill 1026

At the November 12, 2019 C.O.W. meeting, the City Attorney was directed to draft an amendment to the Dangerous Dog ordinance for consideration at the November 26, 2019 C.O.W. meeting.

City Attorney Plant presented an ordinance amending Section 6.06.010 Dangerous Dog Definitions of the Grandview Municipal Code to comply with Laws of 2019, Engrossed House Bill 1026 for consideration.

Discussion took place.

On motion by Councilmember Brewer, second by Councilmember Souders, the C.O.W. moved an ordinance amending Section 6.06.010 Dangerous Dog Definitions of the Grandview Municipal Code to comply with Laws of 2019, Engrossed House Bill 1026 to the December 10, 2019 regular Council meeting for consideration.

C. Snow & Ice Removal Plan

At the November 12, 2019 C.O.W. meeting, staff was directed to draft a new snow removal plan and public media campaign for consideration at the November 26, 2019 C.O.W. meeting.

City Administrator Arteaga presented the new City-Wide Snow & Ice Removal Plan for consideration.

Discussion took place.

Council concurred with the new City-Wide Snow & Ice Removal Plan and directed staff to compile a brochure for distribution to the public and media.

Robert's Rules of Order/Speech Limits in Debate – Mayor Mendoza reminded Council of Robert's Rules of Order regarding speech limits in debate. According to the Robert's Rules, a councilmember may speak in debate twice and each time may speak up to 10 minutes. The maker of the motion would be the first to speak. A councilmember who has not yet spoken would have preference over a councilmember who has already spoken.
