Media Release

The Grandview City Council at their meeting on March 24, 2020 authorized the closure of all City buildings to the public. In an effort to protect the safety of our customers, employees, and the community, the closure will be essential to contain the spread of the coronavirus.

The City of Grandview will continue to provide essential services to citizens that include water, sewer and garbage. Police and Fire services remain available. Effective immediately, City Hall, Police Department, Fire Department, Public Works Department and Parks and Recreation Department buildings and offices will be closed to the public, but staff will continue to report to work to perform their duties. The Grandview Library building which is owned by Yakima Valley College was previously closed in compliance with the Governor's directive for closure of schools and higher education facilities.
