On February 22, 2024, City staff conducted a bid opening for the Old Inland Empire Highway (Welch) Sanitary Sewer Improvements. A total of three (3) bids were received with the low bid of \$1,202,777.64, being offered by C&E Trenching, LLC, of Pasco, WA. This low bid is approximately sixteen (16%) percent above the Engineer's Estimate of \$1,040,477.40.

On March 12, 2024, City Council accepted the bid from C&E Trenching, LLC, and authorized the Mayor to sign all contract documents with C&E Trenching to construct the OIE (Welch) Sanitary Sewer Improvements.

**ITEM COMMENTARY** (Background, discussion, key points, recommendations, etc.) Please identify any or all impacts this proposed action would have on the city budget, personnel resources, and/or residents.

On August 21, 2024, the City of Grandview discovered a sinkhole caused by an undermined sanitary sewer segment on S. Division Street. After initial repairs to this segment, further investigation revealed extensive deterioration along the entire segment. The proposed improvements included replacing two manholes and installing approximately 500 linear feet of new sewer pipe.

Change Order No. 2 compensates the Contractor for emergency sanitary sewer repairs completed on S. Division Street, extending the project completion time by 16 days. The repairs were executed through force account due to the urgent nature of the work. Payment for this work was carefully documented and quantified under the force account provisions of the contract, as directed by the Engineer.

#### **CHANGE ORDER DESCRIPTION:**

Change Order No. 2 compensates the Contractor for emergency sanitary sewer repairs completed on S. Division Street, extending the project completion time by 16 days. The repairs were executed through force account due to the urgent nature of the work. Payment for this work was carefully documented and quantified under the force account provisions of the contract, as directed by the Engineer.

On August 21, 2024, the City of Grandview discovered a sinkhole caused by an undermined sanitary sewer segment on S. Division Street. After initial repairs to this segment, further investigation revealed extensive deterioration along the entire segment. The proposed improvements included replacing two manholes and installing approximately 500 linear feet of new sewer pipe.

### AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GRANDVIEW, WASHINGTON, AMENDING THE CITY OF GRANDVIEW 2025 NON-UNION SALARY SCHEDULE

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Grandview, Washington has adopted a budget for 2025; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council determined during the budget process that a 3.5% general salary increase for all non-union employees be allocated and included on the monthly salary matrix as an integral part thereof;

# AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GRANDVIEW, WASHINGTON, ADOPTING THE BUDGET AND CONFIRMING TAX LEVIES FOR REVENUE TO CARRY ON THE GOVERNMENT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2025

WHEREAS, the City Clerk did publish notice that the Council of the City of Grandview, Washington, would meet on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2024, at 7:00 p.m., in the Council Chambers of the City Hall of said City for the purpose of making and adopting the budget for the fiscal year 2025, and confirming a tax levy based upon the same fiscal year, and giving taxpayers within the limits of said City an opportunity to be heard upon said budget; and

WHEREAS, said City Council did meet at said time and place and did then consider the matter of said proposed budget and tax levy, no objections to the same having been filed with the City Clerk, and no persons appearing to make objections to the same, the Council concluded that the budget was in accord with the needs of the citizens of Grandview; and

WHEREAS, said proposed budget does not exceed the lawful limits of taxation allowed by law to be levied on the property of the City of Grandview for the purposes set forth in said budget, being all necessary to carry on the government of said City during said period,

### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANDVIEW, WASHINGTON, as follows:

**SECTION I.** That the City Council of the City of Grandview hereby adopts by reference the 2025 Annual Budget, which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk of Grandview. That required expenditures for the various departments and needs and operation of government of the City of Grandview, Washington, for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2025, are fixed in the following amounts, to-wit:
